



**Teton County  
Request for Bids  
Equipment & Operators  
June 8, 2016**

**1) Purpose of Request:**

The Teton County Road & Bridge Department is requesting bids from qualified contractors to provide equipment and operators for various projects in Teton County, Idaho at various times during the 2016 summer construction period.

**2) Time Schedule:**

The County will follow the following general timetable:

- a. Issue RFB June 8, 2016
- b. The deadline for submitting the responses is June 17, 10:00 a.m. local time.

**3) Instructions to Proposers:**

- c. An authorized representative of the firm must complete and sign the Bid Form

**4) Terms and Conditions:**

- a. The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive minor irregularities in any RFB response.

- b. The County reserves the right to request clarification of the information submitted, and to request additional information from any respondent.
- c. Any RFB response may be withdrawn up until the date and time set above for opening of the RFB responses.
- d. Companies may submit written questions concerning this RFB to Darryl Johnson via email at [djohnson@co.teton.id.us](mailto:djohnson@co.teton.id.us) no later than 5:00 p.m. local time on June 14, 2016. Questions received after the stated deadline will not be answered. No oral statement of any person shall modify or otherwise change or affect the terms or conditions stated in the RFB, and changes to the RFB, if any, shall be made in writing only and issued in the form of an Addendum to the RFB and highlighted in the RFB.
- e. The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an agreement with Owner to perform all or part of work as specified or indicated in the Bid Form for the prices indicated and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the RFB.
- f. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 30 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

#### **5) Bidder's Representations**

In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:

- a. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- b. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder; information commonly known to contractors doing business in Teton County; information obtained from Bid Documents with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, including applying the specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Bid Documents; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.
- c. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others that relates to the Work as indicated in this RFB.
- d. The Bid Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Bid is submitted.

#### **6) Bidder's Certification**

Bidder certifies that:

- a. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation;
- b. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- c. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and

- d. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract.
- e. “corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process;
- f. “fraudulent practice” means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
- g. “collusive practice” means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and
- h. “coercive practice” means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

## **7) Scope of Work**

Depending on budget appropriations and Contractor unit pricing, County reserves the right to contract with multiple firms depending on the needs of the County. The County will contract with the lowest qualified bidder for each item. If multiple low bids are the same, the county may contract with the low bidder of its choice with availability and past performance taken into consideration.

Equipment and operator will be available for the extent of operation typically from 7:00 am to 5:30 pm and payment will be based on hours worked.

Bidder agrees to comply with Idaho Code 44-1001 through 44-1005, regarding employment of Idaho residents.

Pay request vouchers shall be submitted monthly to the Teton County Road and Bridge Department, 150 Courthouse Drive, Driggs, Idaho 83422. Pay request vouchers will be itemized and shall only charge for times that have been verified by a County designated representative and confirmed by the Contractor.

### **PROJECT 1 SCOPE - Equipment & Operators:**

**Equipment & Operators to assist with various projects through Teton County during the 2016 Construction Season. An example of a typical project is a gravel overlay on a county road where Teton County may contract with a private contractor to assisting in loading, watering, and compacting the gravel. Teton County would spread and grade the gravel in this example.**

- a. The 2016 construction period will be from June, 2016 through October 31, 2016. Bids will be valid for this period.
- b. Scope and estimated time for each individual project will be identified and the contractor notified of this prior to start of work.
- c. Equipment and operator will be available for the extent of each individual project typically from 7:00 am to 5:30 pm and payment will be based on hours worked.
- d. Contractor must have an Idaho Public Works license.

#### Equipment Types:

- a. Water Truck: Water truck and operator will be at the project site as directed by the county representative. Truck will be equipped with a spreader bar, pump, and will be able to draw water from streams, ponds, irrigation lines, or other natural sources. County representative will identify the water source prior to construction.
- b. Front End Loader: Loader and operator will be located at the Driggs Gravel pit as directed by the county representative. Loader will be responsible for loading the material from the county stockpile into belly style dump trucks. Minimum bucket size of 3 cubic yards.
- c. Vibratory Steel Drum Roller: Roller and operator will be located at the project site as directed by the county representative. Roller will be responsible for compacting gravel as it is spread by the motorgrader. Roller shall have a minimum weight of 6 tons.
- d. Excavator/Trackhoe: Excavator and operator will be located at the project site as directed by the county representative. The bucket shall have minimum capacity of 1 Cubic Yard.
- e. Motorgrader/140 HP+: 14' mold board. Motorgrader and operator will be located at the project site as directed by the county representative.
- f. Belly Style-Dump Truck: Truck and operator will haul material from various locations in Teton County to the Project site. Capacity of the truck shall be identified on the bid sheet. County representative will direct the truck and operator throughout the operation.
- g. End Dump Style-Dump Truck: Truck and operator will haul material from various locations in Teton County to the Project site. Capacity of the truck shall be identified on the bid sheet. County representative will direct the truck and operator throughout the operation.

#### **PROJECT 2 SCOPE – Chip Seal Hauling:**

**Trucks and operators to assist in the 2016 Teton County Chip Seal Project by hauling cover coat material (rock chips) to the project site.**

- e. The project is scheduled for June 27th – July 1st. Additional working days may be scheduled to complete the 2016 Chip Spreading Project.
- f. Contractor will provide a dump style truck capable of holding a minimum of 10 cubic yards of material and a licensed operator.
- g. The dump truck will be equipped with a chip spreader bar compatible with the Teton County Chip Spreader.
- h. The dump truck will be equipped with a spreader pan to guide material into the chip spreader's hopper.
