- Installed by Sept. 30, 2014



Dear Mary Lou Hansen,

I would like to submit "Raisin' Cain" bronze rearing stallion overlooking his domain from a Idaho Travertine mountain ridge. The bronze sculpture "Raisin' Cain" is 2 feet in height mounted on a 4 foot high Idaho Travertine ridge. The combination of the two elements create the 6 foot tall "Raisin' Cain" mixed media sculpture. This finished monumental piece is durable and very low maintenance due to the materials used. This piece will be ready for installation in mid June, 2014.

Dear Mary Lou and County commissioners,

As a long time property owner [having painstakingly restored the old Tetonia Ward Church] and practicing Artist in the Valley since 1989. I have a strong affinity with both the Cultural and aesthetic richness of our beautiful diverse valley.

I feel one of my iconic Crystalline Spire's, would act as a wonderful focal point for both our community and visitors in front of the new Law Enforcement Building. The Crystalline Spire shape and use of painted steel would mimic perfectly the majestic Tetons and the style of the new building.

I would be available for the realization and completion of the project both financially and within the projected timeline.

I would be willing to work within the parameters of your budget of \$5000 even though a piece like the one I would propose sell for in excess of \$22,500.

Please find attached my resume, some renderings and an Artist Statement.

I have a few options for you to choose from currently at my Studio. The rendering I have prepared represents one of those pieces. I feel strongly that the placement of the sculpture would be better served in the front of the building to the side roadway pad. This is because I would be concerned about snow plowing and lack of surveillance on the side road placement, but would be happy to work in either area. For the budget proposed, I would provide the sculpture but would expect pick up, delivery and installment to be the County's responsibility.
