

# Notice of a Plant Facilities Election for Teton School District No. 401

Teton County, Idaho

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Plant Facilities Election for Teton School District No. 401, Teton County, State of Idaho, will be held on Tuesday, March 8, 2011 beginning at 8:00 am and closing at 8:00 pm. The purpose of this election shall be to take a vote upon the following question in compliance with Section 33-804 of the Idaho Code:

*QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of Teton County School District No. 401, Teton County, State of Idaho, be authorized to certify a Plant Facilities Levy for five (5) years in the amount of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) per year for capital outlay expenditures including building, roof and parking lot maintenance; technology updates; classroom furniture and vehicle/bus replacement.*

Said election shall be held at the following polling places:

PRECINCT #1 (Victor). Victor LDS Church, 87 East Center, Victor

PRECINCT #2 (Victor-Driggs). Victor LDS Church, 87 East Center, Victor

PRECINCT #3 (Driggs). Teton County Courthouse, Commissioners Meeting Room, 150 Courthouse Drive, Driggs

PRECINCT #4 (Tetonia). Tetonia LDS Church, 6181 South Main, Tetonia

ABSENTEE. Teton County Clerk, 150 Courthouse Drive, Driggs, ID 83422

Notice is further given that only qualified electors of the District, being United States citizens eighteen (18) years of age or older who have resided in the District for thirty (30) days preceding the Plant Facilities Levy Election, who are registered or who register at the polls on the day of the Plant Facilities Levy Election, as provided by law, are entitled to vote at said election.

Any registered elector of the District may make written application to the County Clerk of Teton County, Idaho, in accordance with law for an absentee ballot, provided that an absentee ballot must be received by the County Clerk at the above Absentee address not later than 8:00 pm on the day of the election in order to be counted.

Pursuant to Section 33-804 Idaho Code, if fifty-five percent (55%) of the qualified registered electors voting at the Plant Facilities Levy Election assent to the additional levy for the purpose of capital outlay expenditures for Teton School District No. 401, the additional levy shall be certified to the County Commissioners of Teton County, Idaho, and shall become effective in accordance with provisions of Idaho Code.
