SUBJECT: Addendum 1 - Request for Bid – Solid Waste Hauling Services

The following questions and clarifications have been submitted on the Request for Bid for Solid Waste Hauling Services. The full question/comment is below with the response:

1. *Our companies #1 value is Safety, and as it's written in the proposal: "County employees with CDL's may drive the haulers truck on site as necessary." The liability of this is a big concern. I feel this could be worked out easily, our drivers are at the transfer station several times over the course of a day, or close by that a quick phone call could accommodate your needs.*

A response to this comment is forthcoming pending advice from legal counsel. The response will be posted as Addendum 2 to the website as soon as it becomes available.

2. *In lieu of a flatbed trailer, could a trash trailer with a walking floor work as well?*

A flatbed trailer is required to haul baled materials. The county does not have equipment that could load bales into a trash trailer with a walking floor.

3. *The bid also requires the respondent remove full trailers within two hours of being contacted by Transfer Station. Are there any terms written in for uncontrollable Acts of God for times that the hauling terms are impeded?*

Language will be included in the contract to take into account "Acts of God" such as road closure.

4. *The contract terms state: "The contract may be cancelled for cause or without cause by Teton County or the trucking company upon 30 days written notice." This makes it difficult for any contractor to purchase, lease and or supply equipment required in this bid.*

This language will remain in the contract.
