SUBJECT: Addendum 2 - Request for Bid – Solid Waste Hauling Services

The following questions and clarifications have been submitted on the Request for Bid for Solid Waste Hauling Services. The full question/comment is below with the response:

1. *Our companies #1 value is Safety, and as it's written in the proposal: "County employees with CDL's may drive the haulers truck on site as necessary." The liability of this is a big concern. I feel this could be worked out easily, our drivers are at the transfer station several times over the course of a day, or close by that a quick phone call could accommodate your needs.*

Changes to section "A) Trash Hauling to Circular Butte Landfill" are indicated below in bold :

- A) Trash Hauling to Circular Butte Landfill:
- a) The haul truck must be capable of carrying a minimum of 23 tons per load.
 - b) The load must be covered.
 - c) The trucking company is responsible for the material during transport and any unforeseen and unintended clean-up.
 - d) The trucking company is responsible for any tickets received while hauling material from the transfer station. This includes but is not limited to overweight tickets.
 - e) The trucking company is responsible for any damage their drivers cause on equipment when entering and leaving the transfer station.
 - f) **The trucking company must be on site and ready and able to move their equipment (including trucks and trailers) within thirty minutes of a request.** ~~Teton County is liable for any damages caused to trucking equipment by County personnel and equipment.~~

- g) The trucking company shall manage the repair process from damage caused by the County and will pass on the repair cost to the County.
- h) The trucking company shall make a truck and trailer available on the transfer station site at all times.
- i) **If the trucking company cannot move their equipment within 30 minutes of a request for it to be moved, then trucking company hereby expressly gives any Teton County employees with a commercial drivers license (CDL) permission to move the equipment, including any truck and/or trailer.** ~~County employees with their CDL may drive the truck onsite as necessary.~~
- j) Trucking company employees shall follow all Transfer Station safety rules including but not limited to the hard hat requirement in the truck tunnel.
- k) The contractor shall operate in compliance with OSHA and DOT regulations. Contractors shall possess and keep in force all licenses, business permits and other permits required to perform the services of this agreement.
