EXPLANATION OF FEES

COUNTY

Cost of running the county, i.e. court, law enforcement, elections, property tax assessment and collection, probation, jail, emergency management, noxious weeds, planning and zoning.

Insurance

Levy passed in 2016 for 5 years, capital outlay expenditures, \$420,000 for 2016

Passed in 2014 for 2 years and renewed (or not) every 2 years

Refinancing of 1996 and 2006 bonds (Middle School and High School)

SPECIAL ROAD LEVY

Passed in 2016 for 2 years, renews (or not) every two years

ROAD AND BRIDGE

County Operating Fund

CEMETERY

Pertinent to physical location (Driggs-Darby, Victor-Cedron, Cache-Clawson, Cem-Haden, Cem-Bates)

FIRE PROTECTION

Fire District, taxing district created in 1996, now also provides Ambulance Services

LIBRARY

Victor Library (created 30 years ago)

LIBRARY SPECIAL

Driggs Library, voters approved permanent increase in Nov. 2015

MOSQUITO ABATEMENT

Taxing district created about 6 years ago

SPECIAL FEES:

- WATER
- FOREST
- SOLID WASTE FEE

Levied by the state, \$60.00 per diversion, sometimes split between adjacent parcels.

Call 208-525-7167, private lands fire assessment.

\$14.00 per bare ground parcel and \$97.00 per household and business to cover operating costs of Transfer station and land fill cap.
