Review of August 4<sup>th</sup> minutes – Unanimous vote to adopt the minutes with the caveat that the spelling and grammar needs to be corrected.

### **DISCUSSION –**

Angie explained that at the last “map meeting” at the Senior Center there were several common themes that emerged from all 5 working groups that emerged in the workshop:

- Decreased density outside the cities
- Economic development component
- Pathways
- Protection of extremely sensitive areas (ie: wetlands)

Today’s deliverable is to come up a list of likes, dislikes, and corrections/clarifications with each of these 3 maps.

Anna’s question about lack of consensus re: the recreation center. Response: This is not an implementation plan, but really, these maps show what is possible. This is the big picture. Hyrum commented that recreation could be controlled by the county (ie: that is what is done in King County, WA). This would make more sense than having the cities run the recreation centers.

The group then reviews and discusses the 3 maps. We wrote down our comments on the large pieces of paper. Then, the group reviewed our comments between the three scenarios and made sure that the comments reflected the group’s vision. See the large sheets of paper for specific comments.
