

**MINUTES OF THE TETON COUNTY LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING  
COMMITTEE/CITIZEN CORPS COUNCIL MEETING**

**July 6, 2010**

The Teton County Local Emergency Planning Committee met on **July 6, 2010**, at 3:30 p.m., at the Teton County Courthouse. LEPC Chairperson Tony Goe, Emergency Management Coordinator Greg Adams, ISP Trooper Dustin Green, Eastern Idaho Public Health District Tammy Cox and Mike Dronen, Teton Fire Protection District Assistant Chief Bret Campbell, Teton Valley Ambulance Director Jim Gaines, Teton County Sheriff's Office Dispatch Supervisor Valee Wells, Teton Valley Hospital Bonnie Burlage, Idaho Fish & Game Officer Lauren Wendt, Teton County ARES/RACES David Dean, Teton School District Superintendent Monte Woolstenhulme, City of Victor Scott Golden, Search & Rescue Commander Kelly Circle, Britt Vanshur 101<sup>st</sup> WMD Civil Support Team, were in attendance.

**Review/Acceptance of Minutes**

The minutes were reviewed, Bonnie Burlage made a motion to accept the minutes as written, second by Tony Goe and the motion passed unanimously.

**101<sup>st</sup> WMD Civil Support Team Briefing**

Britt Vanshur of this Boise based 22 person military/national guard team informed us of the capabilities of this team. Capabilities include:

- **Support** for domestic searches and events
- **Assistance** with chemical, biological and radiological emergencies/disasters
- **Deployment** through Boise State Com 1-800-632-8000. Strike team may arrive by helicopter or heavy airlift out of Cheyenne, WY, depending on the disaster.
- **Communications** with 2 Satellite Phones, wireless computers, video conferencing, and a Unified Command Suite vehicle equipped with all of the above.
- **Survey** which identifies the threat and projects further threats to the communities.
- **Analytical Laboratory System** which provides field analysis of chemical or biological agents
- **Medical and Decon.**
- **Regional Response Team Interagency Cooperation:** Offers year-round drills / table-top up to full scale

**4th of July Celebration Critique:**

- **Huntsman Springs** – Snow fence walkway through the center of the crowd with 4 openings to divide the driving range into 4 sections for easier identification of areas and better access to possible emergencies. Cordon off the fireworks area and provide light for the pyrotechs. Give maps to more people. Better communications between golf maintenance & EMS & Tony & Parking & Dispatch & Sheriff etc.
- **Balloons** - Pilots did not listen to instructions. Don't scare the buffalo. Avoid the water. Who is liable of an accident or drowning? Who is the balloon master and who reviews the rules with the pilots? Tony will talk to Reed.
- **Parade** - In Victor the children were too close to the floats and horses. Need more volunteers and search and rescue patrols. Need more barricades and signs. Kelly will use the sheriff's work detail to help to build more barricades and signs. Candlestick cones can be borrowed or rented from construction companies or ITD. Tony brought up the concern that the parade went too fast and the entries were too close together.
- **Command Post** – For the parade and the Huntsman Springs event Jim suggested a unified command with the main dispatch to remain in the old courthouse. This may reduce confusion.
- **Tabletop** – Very useful. Have all agencies involved designate their representative for the unified command of each event before the tabletop exercise next year.

**August CPR/AED Training**

x112. Assignments for instructors: Marc Anderson TVFD = 2 manikins, Tammy Cox and Holly Peterson EIPHD = 10 adult manikins and 2 defibrillator trainers, Sandra = 4 adult manikins and 1 defibrillation trainer and the paperwork. Cost for each participant will be \$5.25.
