

**MINUTES OF THE TETON COUNTY LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING  
COMMITTEE/CITIZEN CORPS COUNCIL MEETING**

April 3, 2012

The Teton County Local Emergency Planning Committee met at 3:30 p.m., at the Teton County Courthouse. Teton Valley Ambulance and LEPC Chairman Rob Veilleux; Emergency Management Coordinator Greg Adams; Teton Valley News Ken Levy; Teton School District 401 Superintendent Monte Woolstenhulme; Idaho Bureau of Homeland Security Mike Clements; Teton County Fire Protection District Scott Wood; Teton County Planning Angie Rutherford; Teton County Search and Rescue Kelly Circle; Idaho State Police Tony Anderson; and Teton Valley Hospital Bonnie Burlage were in attendance.

**Meeting was called to order @ 3:30pm by Rob Veilleux, Chairman**

**Review/Acceptance of Minutes:**

The minutes were reviewed and accepted as presented.

**Project Status Board:**

- Next exercise is the second half of the statewide one on April 10 & 11, 2012. Teton County and Teton Valley Hospital will be participating on the 10<sup>th</sup>. All towns in the county will be doing Windshield Surveys. Red Cross will set up a mass shelter at the fairgrounds about 9am, and will be open from 10am to 2pm. We will have about 25 high school students as victims beginning at 12:30pm.
- Special needs population – TCEM and EIPHD met with leaders from 3 different churches on March 22, 2012. Goals were identified:
  1. Identification of special needs people in our county.
  2. Determine how we can help.

**Program:** Karl Dehart, BHS Web EOC Program Manager spoke to us about information sharing via Web EOC. He would like to see more Idaho entities using Web EOC for internal county or agency communication, such as significant planned events (i.e. 4<sup>th</sup> of July) as well as disasters. It could also be used for LEPC meetings and program details.

**Agency Reports:**

- Teton Valley Hospital - Flu season is winding down, and emergency visits are up. We will be exercising our evacuation plan on the 10<sup>th</sup> of April during the state exercise.
- SAR – Call-outs have slowed. 12 searches so far this year. Currently 36 members. Ropes course June 1-3, 2012 will cost about \$6000.00.
- ISP – Introduced Tony Anderson who is the District 6 Haz-Mat Specialist.
- Teton School Dist. 401 – Spring Break is over.
