SCHOOL DISTRICT 401 :	Taxes relating to the school district are listed below: 208-228-5923
• TORT	Insurance
• EMERGENCY	Passed yearly , as needed
• PLNT FACILITIES	Levy passed in 2016 for 5 years, capital outlay expenditures, \$440,000 for 2017
• SUPPLEMENTAL	Passed in 2018 for 2 years and renewed (or not) every 2 years
• BOND 2006	Refinancing of 1996 and 2006 bonds (Middle School and High School)
• 2006 REFI UR-N	Refinancing of 1996 and 2006 bonds (Middle School and High School) doesn't pay into UR
• BONDS 2017	Bonds used to construct two new elementary schools+ renovations, improvements, and additions to other schools Term 2038

FIRE PROTECTION	Fire District, taxing district created in 1996, now also provides Ambulance Services 208-715-5201

MOSQUITO ABATEMENT	Taxing district created in 2011 208-354-2703
FLOOD DISTRICT	Flood Control District 208-354-3344

• WATER	Levied by the state, sometimes split between different parcels, if properties are close together 208-525-7161
• FOREST	Call 208-525-7167, private lands fire assessment
• SOLID WASTE FEE	\$108.00 per improved structures on parcel, covers part of operating costs of transfer station & land fill cap 354-8775
