



Transfer Station Temporarily Closed Due to Fire

Due to a fire on Monday September 13, 2021, the Teton County Transfer Station will be temporarily closed for repairs. The cause of the fire is unknown at this time. Once the fire investigation is complete, that information will be provided.

The entire transfer station runs off one electrical panel that did not survive the fire. Therefore, the scale house is without power. An electrician will be assessing the damage and plans for repair today, September 14, 2021. Pending the outcome of structural and electrical analysis, the facility *may* reopen for limited services on Thursday September 16th, 2021. Trash service provided through RAD Curbside will continue operating on a normal schedule until further notice. They will achieve this by hauling to the Madison County Transfer Station. For more information please visit www.radcurbside.com. Once the building is deemed structurally safe, the processing of commercial loads can resume. Further details will be provided as soon as they are available.
