SOME IMPORTANT REMINDERS

CLG Grants are reimbursable and all associated costs must be eligible as outlined in the Idaho CLG Grants Manual. All initial payments must be made by the Certified Local Government, and only costs incurred during the project timeline can be reimbursed. We can only reimburse mileage at 65.5 cents/mile, and all per diems are reimbursed at the Idaho State rates, not the GSA rates, in accordance with State of Idaho Travel policies.

You can begin reaching out to and communicating with potential consultants for your project at this time. However, you may not sign a formal contract with them until the grant agreement has been fully executed¹ and the SHPO has received authorization from the NPS to expend funds. For FY23 grants, all projects must be completed, and closeout paperwork submitted no later than September 1, 2025.

Please keep us informed of the progress of your projects. If you have any delays, questions, or concerns please contact us as soon as possible. We look forward to your projects and working with you all!

¹ In order to finalize the grant contract, each CLG will need a Unique Entity ID (UEI). It is likely your CLG already has a UEI as entities registering in SAM.gov are assigned a UEI as a part of the registration process. For those that do not, more guidance on how to register will be provided in the coming months.
