Old Business:

A. 2018 LEPC Activity Status Board was reviewed.

New Business:

A. Explored Concepts and Planning of Spring 2019 Exercise

B. Emergency Action Plans were distributed to agencies/departments.

Agency Reports: The only agency report updates were as follows:

Teton County Emergency Management: Teton County EM was awarded with a PDM grant for its Critical Power Project. The grant will allow for manual transfer switches to be installed in 8 public buildings. Also the purchase of two generators.

Teton Valley Hospital: New Lab equipment has been acquired. The Hospital Billing Dept will be moving into the former Thrift Store location.

City of Teton: Getting the second pump installed on the new water system. On January 19 the Snow Plane Rally will take place.

City of Victor: A new City Planning Director, Ryan Krueger, attended the meeting. Planning is reviewing the new Flood Risk Map.

City of Driggs: A new City Airport Coordinator, Lori Kyle, attended the meeting.

American Red Cross: Red Cross is still providing free smoke alarms to the community.
