Meeting was called to order @ 3:30pm.

Review/Approve October 3, 2017 Minutes: The minutes were reviewed and approved.

Old Business:

- A. Project Status Board - no update

New Business:

- A. 101st Weapons of Mass Destruction Civil Support Team Briefing and Vehicle Display was cancelled.
- B. National Weather Service Winter Outlook was given by Travis Wyatt. The winter outlook was compared to last year's winter season. Handouts were provided as a resource for LEPC members.
- C. All Hazard Mitigation Plan were handout to those agencies in attendance. Also a discussed was the need to update the mitigation projects within the Plan in the month of December.

Agency Reports: The only agency report updates were as follows:

Emergency Management: EM will be submitting a 4246 Grant to purchase two portable generators and installation of manual transfer switches for essential facilities. EM will set-up a meeting with County and Cities Public Works staff to discuss a reduction of those sites and prioritize the sites for the grand submittal. The SHSP 2016 Grant for new batteries has been approved by IOEM and the batteries have been ordered. EM is currently working on SHSP 2017 Grant which includes Search and Rescue purchase of watercraft equipment.

Teton County Sheriff: The Sheriff radios have been programmed. The Sheriff inquired about radio coverage improving in the Valley, where reception in some areas creates problems.

Teton Valley Hospital: A new CT has been ordered and will be installed by the end of the month. A temporary emergency generator will be in service during the CT installation to ensure that the Hospital is ready for an emergency.

Teton County Road & Bridge: 2017 project have been completed. Preparing for snow plowing winter season.

City of Teton: The City Water Project has begun and will break for the winter season and start-up again in the Springs 2018. The Water Project is the replacement of the water truck lines for the city.

City of Driggs: The City's Water Project has been shut down for the winter season. It will start-up again in Spring 2018. The new City Transit Station is near completed.
