Emergency Management: EM will be submitting a Grant to purchase two portable generators and installation of manual transfer switches for essential facilities.

Teton County Commission: An Active Shooter Training will be scheduled in January 2018 to include two sessions. Also, a PIO Boot Camp Training was attended and the training will be shared with other local PIO's.

Teton Valley Hospital: A new CT has been installed.

Teton County Road & Bridge: New snow plow truck will be purchased in 2018.

Fire District:

Fire District received a State and US Forest Service grant for vegetation removal in the southwest area of Teton Valley.

American Red Cross: The Red Cross will continue to work with the Fire District on distribution of smoke alarms. It was expressed from the committee that distribution could be from the local Food Bank.

Eastern Idaho Public Health District: Public Health has scheduled an inventory of medical resources at the Armory on January 13, 2018, 11:00am.

Idaho Office of Emergency Management: Field Agent will continue to support the county. A scheduled EM Workshop is set for December 14, 2017 (8-5pm).

Teton School District 401: The School Bond has passed, design and construction will be scheduled.

US Forest Service: US Forest Service is involved in the southwest area fuel reduction grant and project with the Fire District.
