- E. 911 Roll-Out for the Sheriff's Office was provided by John Leidorf who described the upgrade to the 911 Dispatch system.

Agency Reports: The only agency report updates were as follows:

Teton County Sheriff: The Sheriff Office is fully staffed with Deputies and Dispatch.

Teton County Commissioners: Emergency Management, Search and Rescue, and Hospital to remain in the Armory as a short term plan. Road and Bridge will be planning a new facility. Also, upcoming CPR sessions will be available to staff members.

Teton County Road & Bridge: Under planning efforts to assist with the design new facility.

City of Teton: The Public Works Director will be out of the office for several months.

Teton Valley Hospital: The new Victor Clinic may be completed and open in July 2018.

Eastern Idaho Public Health: The 2018 Public Health Rendezvous will be held on April 3 & 4, 2018. Brochures on the event will be distributed soon. Also an April Hospital Exercise may occur.
