Agency Reports: The only agency report updates were as follows:

Teton County Emergency Management: Teton County EM was awarded with a State grant for its Critical Power grant. The grant will allow for manual transfer switches to be installed in 8 public buildings. Also the purchase of two generators.

Teton Valley Hospital: The new City of Victor Medical Clinic is open. Also, the TVH has a new brand on their material and website.

Teton County Fire Protection District: Fire has received the 2017 grant SHSP floatation devices and throw bags. On Sunday, August 5, 2018, Teton County Fire Protection District responded to a local fire on the BLM property, later called Game Creek Canyon Fire. Fire was put out, and firefighters remain several days after for protection.

American Red Cross: This summer has keep the Red Cross busy opening shelters around the region. Red Cross is on alert until mid-September. Red Cross has deployed 17-18 volunteers to California.

Eastern Idaho Public Health: Tammy Cox, Preparedness Department Director has retired. Active Shooter Response Course Instructor is available. EIPH Emergency Operation Plan has been updated and will be distributed to agencies. IOEM will conduct an exercise next year which may include various counties and hospitals.
