Old Business:

- A. 2018 LEPC Activity Status Board was reviewed.

New Business:

- A. Continuity of Operations Plans (COOP) Workshop

A discuss took place to explain that the Continuity of Operations Plan addressed individual departments and agencies essential functions, order of succession, and alternate facilities continued to be performed during a wide range of emergencies. EM staff reviewed the entire COOP template with everyone and answered questions as they were raised.

- B. National Preparedness Course E0912 "Community Specific Planned Approach to Hazards"

Agency Reports: The only agency report updates were as follows:

Teton County Emergency Management: Teton County EM was awarded with a State grant for its Critical Power grant. The grant will allow for manual transfer switches to be installed in 8 public buildings. Also the purchase of two generators. A Request for Qualifications will be sent-out. A Letter of Intent has been approved by the Commissioners on a PDM generator project for the Teton County Courthouse. Ronn Carlentine has been added to the EM staff as a Full-Time employee starting September 24, 2018.

Teton Valley Hospital: The new City of Victor Medical Clinic is open. Also, the TVH has a new brand (Teton Health) on their material and website. Hospital has applied for a Quality Grant. A new Emergency Room Coordinator has been hired.

Teton County Fire Protection District: Fire Protection District has sent-out firefighters to other areas to fight fires.

Eastern Idaho Public Health: Wet Nile has been detected in the area with one human case reported. Next Coalition Meeting will be held on September 20, in Idaho Falls Public Health Building.

Teton Community Animal Shelter: Price Gilroy was introduced to the group. Price is the new Animal Shelter Manager.

City of Tetonia: Jay Beard was introduced to the group. Jay is the new Tetonia Public Works Manager.

City of Victor: City representative was present and no report provided.

Search & Rescue: S&R representative was present and no report provided.
