**Review/Approve September 5, 2017 Minutes:** The minutes were reviewed and approved.

### Old Business:

- A. Project Status Board - no update
- B. 2017 Total Solar Eclipse – Lessons Learned  
Discussion raised two items; the risk analysis for an event to estimate visitors may need to be enhanced by gathering data from more reliable source(s), and actual count of traffic and people may have provided comparable data for future events.

### New Business:

- A. 2017 Eclipse After Action Report – The report was pass-out to attendees and the Event strengths and improvements were discussed.
- B. The Teton County Emergency Plans involved a brief review and discussion of the All Hazard Mitigation Plan, Emergency Operations Plan, and Continuity of Operations Plan. Necessary updates to these Plans will require the cooperation of the cities and county departments. The goal is to work with Participants in the next several months to completed these updates to the Plans.
- C. All Hazard Mitigation Plan was discussed and the need to update the mitigation projects within the Plan in the month of December. Also, if cities and county departments could budget 25% of the matching funds for a project, the project would be in line for possible Grant funding.

**Agency Reports:** The only agency report updates were as follows:

Emergency Management: 2016 SHSP Grants have been completed. EM will be submitting a 2017 Hazard Mitigation Grant to purchase two portable generators and installation of manual transfer switches for essential sites.

City of Tetonia: City of Tetonia has accepted the construction bid for new Water Project which will replace the main water pipeline system for the City.

Teton Valley Hospital: A new CT will be installed by the end of the year.

Teton County Fire Protection District: The District has sent two firefighting personnel northwest to the Bell Fire.

Idaho State Police: State Police may have experienced communication difficulty during the Eclipse which may need to be addressed at a later time.

Eastern Idaho Public Health: A new staff Planner has been hired.

Idaho Office of Emergency Management: Grants must be completed before the grant period has ended. Teton County has completed its current year grant process.
