When compiling the election abstract Wednesday morning which includes precinct details, the Clerk realized the absentee ballots had not been included in the posted election night results. The results were then immediately corrected on the Secretary of State's website.

The error was due to a miscommunication regarding which report contained the final results that included both absentee and election day numbers. Initially on election night, only election day results were reported. This was not a counting error. It was a reporting error, an honest human mistake that was corrected as soon as possible.

Per Idaho Code 34-1205 the Board of Canvassers has ten days to certify the election at which time results become official. This delay allows for an audit of results to ensure the integrity of the election.
